HOW DO I BECOME A MEMBER?

- 3) Present your receipt and proof of residency to the gatehouse attendant at your first visit. If you paid online, you will be given your membership card at your first visit. Present your membership card and proof of your Standish residency each time you visit.






BEACH CLOSURE INFORMATION




Explore Rich Memorial Beach

Located at 100 Newbegin Way. From Sebago
Lake Village at the corner of Rt. 114 and Rt. 35,
travel North on Rt. 114 (Richville Rd) then take
a right onto Harmons Beach Road. Take a right
onto Newbegin Way. Follow Newbegin way
until you reach the beach gate house and
parking lot. No parking on roadway.

Respect residents in the neighborhood and please
obey the posted speed limit.



Rich Memorial Beach Rules:

No Lifeguard on Duty. Swim at Own Risk.

- 1. Summer access is for Town of Standish resident members only.
- 2. Winter access for ice fishing is open to the public from ice-in to ice-out.
- 3. Littering is prohibited. Trash is carry-in, carry-out.
- 4. No pets are allowed. Service dogs are allowed.
- 5. For water quality and public health, children in diapers or swim diapers are NOT permitted in water.
- 6. Do not feed waterfowl. They are extremely harmful to water quality.
- 7. No fishing in designated swimming area.
- 8. No glass bottles/containers.
- 9. No fires, sparklers or fireworks allowed on beach.
- 10. No grills on beach. Grills may be used in designated area near parking lot.
- 11. This is a tobacco, drug, vaping and alcohol-free facility.
- 12. Respectful and neighborly conduct is enforced.
- 13. Children under age 14 must be supervised by an adult.
- 14. No ATV's, golf carts or dirt bikes allowed.
- 15. The Town of Standish accepts no liability for loss or damage to vehicles or their contents. Parking is at the user's own risk and is restricted to designated areas.
- 16. No motor homes, campers, or trailers during summer season.
- 17. No overnight parking. Gate will be locked when beach is closed.

Enforcement of these rules and others is by Town of Standish. Memberships can be revoked for violation of rules.
